



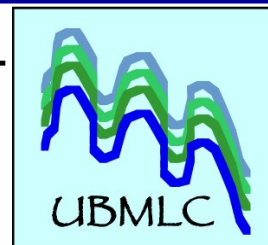

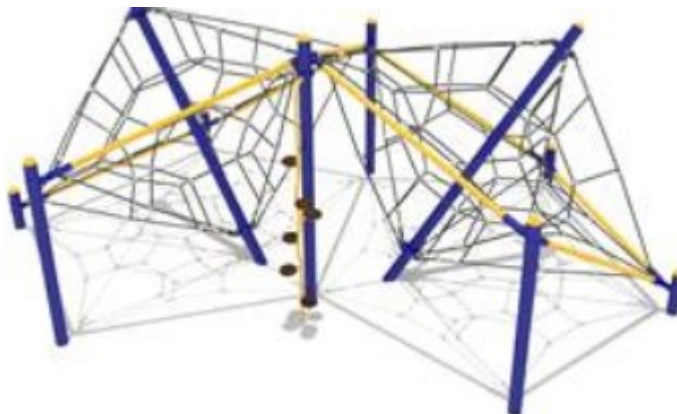


New Teacher!!!!

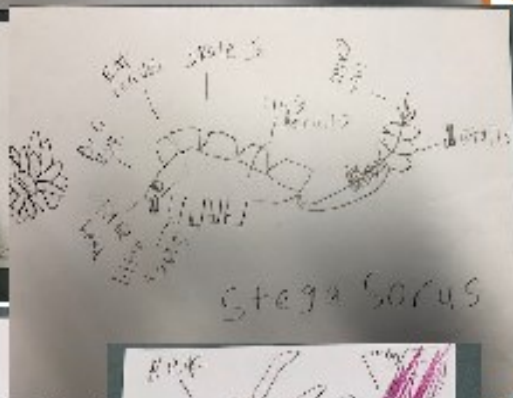
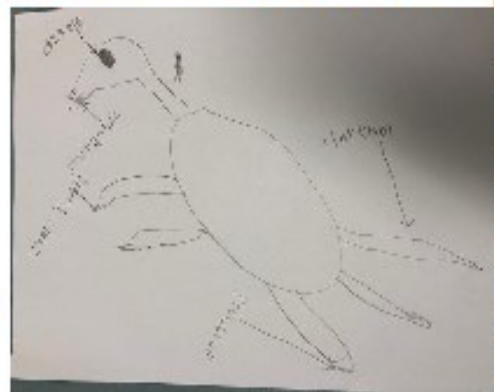
